**KEY FACTS**: Big plays in the game included a surprise onsides kick by New Orleans to open the second half that the Saints recovered. Trailing 10-6 at the break, the Saints

scored ten third-quarter points to take the lead. The tinal big play was a 74-yard interception return touchdown by Saints' DB Tracy Porter that sealed it for New Orleans.
