Storyline: Baltimore, behind two touchdowns from wide receiver/kick return **Jacoby Jones (Lane)**, one on a 56-yard reception and the other on a 108-yard kickoff return to start the second half, jumped out to a 28-6 lead and then held on withstood a furious second-half San Francisco comeback to prevail in Super Bowl XLVII, 34-31. The game featured the first-ever Super Bowl power failure in the third quarter that caused a 34-minute delay in game action.

Baltimore

Jacoby Jones, WR/KR (Lane)

One kickoff return returned for SB-record 108 yards for TD among 206 kickoff return yards in five returns (41.2 yards per return). Also caught one pass for 56 yards and a TD. Also had two punt returns for 28 yards. Totalled 290 all-purpose yards in Ravens win.

- Returns first punt of the game 17 yards.

- Returns kickoff after first-quarter San Francisco field goal for 31 yards to Baltimore 22-yard line (took the kickoff nine yards deep in the end zone).

- Muffs second-quarter punt but recovers and runs for 11 yards.

Three plays later, catches 56-yard touchdown pass down the middle from quarterback Joe Flacco (Baltimore 21, San Francisco 3, :22). Jones fell, got up, dodged defenders and went into the end zone.

- Returns the second-half kickoff 108 yards for a touchdown (Baltimore 28, San Francisco 6, 14:49).

- After San Francisco pulls to within 28-13 in third quarter, returns kickoff 22 yards to Baltimore 17 (starts five yards deep in end zone).

- After San Francisco draws to 28-23 on David Akers field goal late in third quarter, returns ensuing kickoff 25 yards.

- After San Francisco touchdown leaves Niners trailing 31-29, returns ensuing kickoff 21 yards.

Adrian Hamilton, LB (Prairie View) ≥

Back-up left outside linebacker had one solo stop in Ravens' win.

- Stops 49ers running back Frank Gore for no gain in first quarter.

Ramone Harewood, OT (Morehouse)

Back-up right offensive tackle in win over San Francisco.

Anthony Levine, DB (Tennessee State) - Did not suit up in Ravens' win.

Nigel Carr, LB (Alabama State) - Did not suit up in Ravens' win

Christian Thompson, DB (South Carolina State) - Did not suit up in Raven's win.

Lamar Divens, DB (Tennessee State)

Did not suit up in Niners' loss.

Ricardo Lockette, WR (Fort Valley State)

Did not suit up on Niners' loss.

MVP: Joe Flacco, QB, Baltimore - 22 of 33, 287 yards, 3 TDs

KEY FACTS: Baltimore wide receiver/kick returner **Jacoby Jones (Lane)** set or tied six Super Bowl records with his performance in Super Bowl XLVII. Jones set four records for,

- 1) *The longest scoring play* with his 108-yard kickoff return touchdown to open the second half,
- 2) *The longest play* with the 108-yard kick return,
- 3) *The longest kickoff return* with the 108-yarder,
- 4) *The most yards gained in a Super Bowl* with 290 total yards.

Jones tied two records for,

- 1) *Most touchdowns (2) plays of 50 yards or more (Ricky Sanders, Washington, XXII), and*
- 2) *Most kickoff return touchdowns (1) in a game (Nine others).*

The Ravens' win allowed middle linebacker Ray Lewis to go out a winner as he retired after the game.
