- **ISAIAH CROWELL**, RB, New York Jets - (5th season, **ALABAMA STATE**) - Led Jets with 13 carries for 25 yards with a long run of 7 yards in loss to Chicago. Also had one 13-yard reception.
 - **TERRON ARMSTEAD**, OT, New Orleans (6th season, **ARKANSAS-PINE BLUFF**) - Anchored left side of Saints line in 30-20 win over Minnesota. Offense produced a season-low of 164 passing yards but rushed for 106 yards. Armstead and his cohorts on the offensive line kept QB Drew Brees from being sacked.
 - **CHESTER ROGERS**, WR/KR, Indianapolis (3rd season, **GRAMBLING STATE**) - One punt return for 10 yards in win over Oakland.
 - **CHAD WILLIAMS**, WR, Arizona (2nd season, **GRAMBLING STATE**) - Had two receptions for 21 yards in win over San Francisco.

POISED TO POUNCE!

Indianapolis rookie linebacker **Darius Leonard** (#53, **SOUTH CAROLINA STATE**), well on his way to Pro Bowl season, gets ready for the Raiders Sunday during the Colts' 42-28 win. Leonard led the Colts with nine tackles, four solos in the win. In seven games this season, Leonard has had double-figure tackles in four games with a high of 19 vs. Washington. He also had 17 vs. Buffalo and 13 vs. Houston and Philadelphia. In the three games he did not reach double-digits, he had 9, 9 and 8 stops. The rookie leads the NFL in tackles with 58 despite missing one game.



ARMSTEAD CLEARS THE WAY!

Former **ARKANSAS-PINE BLUFF** and **SWAC** standout lineman **TERRON ARMSTEAD** (#72) clears the way for one of Alvin Kamara's (#41) two touchdowns Sunday in the Saints win over Minnesota. At 6-5, 304 pounds, experts say Armstead, now a left offensive tackle for the New Orleans Saints, is a serious candidate for All-Pro honors and is quick and agile enough to be a tight end in the league.
