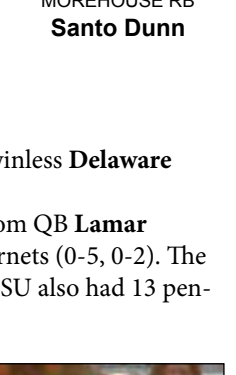

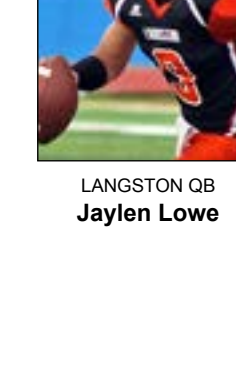
Morgan State started the fourth quarter on a 64-yard drive capped by a 13-yard Jordan Riggins TD run to go up 18-14 at the 10:55 mark. It stayed that way until SCSU took over at its own 20 with 2:24 to play. Nick (11-21-0, 139 yards) ran for 9 yards and completed three passes during the 80-yard drive before hitting Cummings with the game winner. In the final drive, MSU drove to the SCSU 22 before QB DeAndre Harris was intercepted by Scott Robinson at the 14 with :12 seconds left.

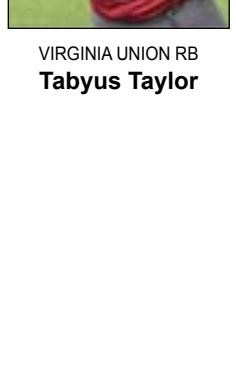

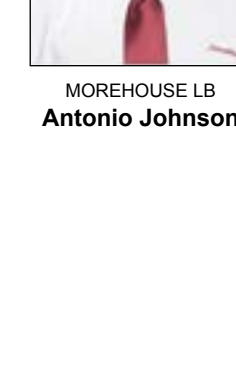

- MEAC SHOWDOWN: The two undefeated teams in MEAC play meet in Greensboro, N.C. Saturday when defending champion North Carolina A&T (5-1, 2-0 MEAC) hosts Florida A&M (4-2, 3-0) at 1 p.m. The game will also match first-year head coaches in A&Ts Sam Washington and FAMU's Willie Simmons. Washington, a Mississippi Valley State product who played four seasons at defensive back in the NFL, spent the last seven years as defensive coordinator for former A&T head coach Rod Broadway. Simmons, who played quarterback at Clemson, was the offensive coordinator at Alcorn State before spending three years as head coach at Prairie View A&M. AIR RAIDED!: The Air Raid offense did not last long at Jackson State. Hal Mumme, the creator of the pass-happy offensive scheme tabbed the AIR RAID offense stepped down as offensive coordinator at JSU last week. "I would like to thank Hal Mumme for his contributions to the Jackson State football program," head coach Tony Hughes said in a press release. "We wish Hal nothing but success going forward." Mumme, the former University of Kentucky head coach credited with revolutionizing college football with his schemes, came to JSU after serving as head coach at Bellhaven where his team averaged 55 passes per game. At JSU, his offense had passed for 118 yards in a loss to Southern Miss, 270 in a win over Florida A&M, and 123 in a loss to Alabama A&M. The JSU offense had not scored 20 points in any of those games. Receiver coach Derrick McCall, who has been on the JSU coaching staff for eight years and served as OC in the 2012-2013 season, will serve as interim offensive coordinator.
