## BIG WINNERS!

**• North Carolina A&T • South Carolina State • Alcorn State**

**• Bethune-Cookman • Virginia Union • Fayetteville State • Alabama A&M • Albany State**

**• AGGIES DOMINATE!** - BCSP No. 1 North Carolina A&T got 199 rushing yards and three TDs from **Jah-Maine Martin** and three TD passes from QB **Kyil Carter** in demolishing Norfolk State 58-19.

Martin, the MEAC's leading rusher, got his total on just ten carries including TD runs of 2, 68 and 67 yards. Carter completed just 9 of 14 passes for 176 yards without a pick including two scoring passes to **Zach Leslie** (4 rec., 106 yds.) covering 26 and 68 yards.

The Aggies (4-1, 2-0 MEAC) defense picked off three passes of NSU QB **Jwan Carter** (24-44-3, 252 yards) and sacked him four times.

**• NICK LET LOOSE!** - Redshirt junior QB **Tyce Nick** (16-28-1) threw for 253 yards and five TDs and ran for 105 yards (14 carries), as BCSP No. 2 **South Carolina State** (3-1, 1-0 MEAC) downed **Delaware State**, 38-24.

**Demontrez Burroughs** (5 rec, 99 yds.) hauled in two of Nick's scoring tosses of 21 and 28 yards. Nick also hit **Shaquan Davis** from 37 yards out to open the scoring and connected with **Will Vereen** on a 50-yard score and **Rodriguez Thoms** on a 10-yard strike in the third quarter.

**• BCSP No. 3 Alcorn State** got four first-half turnovers and three TD passes and one rushing TD from QB **Felix Harper** en route to a 35-7 win over **Alabama State**.

The Braves (4-2, 2-0 SWAC E) led 28-0 at the break after Alabama State QB **Kha'Darris Davis** (12-26-4, 161 yds.) was picked off three times and lost a fumble in the first half.

**Harper** (10-17, 146 yds.) hit **LeCharles Pringle** from 8 yards out after Davis was picked off on ASU's first play from scrimmage. Harper scored from 18 yards out after Davis fumbled on the Hornets' second possession. Harper later hit **Nigel Wood** on an 18-yard strike to put the Braves up 21-0.

RB **Niko Duffey** (9 carries, 101 yds.) punctuated the first-half scoring as he scampered 67 yards to paydirt to give the Braves a 28-0 halftime lead.

Harper added a fourth-quarter 22-yard scoring pass to **Raidarius Anderson** to cap the scoring for the Braves.

The start of the game was delayed four hours because of lightning in the Lorman, Ms. area.

**• Senior QB Akevious Williams** (16-23-0) passed for 156 yards and three scores and ran for 114 yards and one score to lead BCSP No. 4 **BETHUNE-COOKMAN** to a 31-20 win over **Morgan State**.

The Wildcats (4-1, 2-0 MEAC) only led 10-6 at the half, their only TD coming on a 64-yard run by Williams. But B-CU got two TDs from Williams to WR **Jimmie Robinson** in the third quarter covering 70 and 6 yards to build a 24-6 lead.

Robinson (5 rec., 136 yds., 3 TDs) added a 44-yard TD reception in the fourth quarter that put B-CU up 31-13.

**• BCSP No. 8 VIRGINIA UNION** got 215 passing yards and four TDs from QB **Khalid Morris** (14-26-0) as they knocked **Livingstone** from the undefeated ranks, 44-0.

Morris hit wideout **Charles Hall** (6 rec., 129 yds.) with 38- and 48-yard scoring tosses and also connected with **Hakeem Holland** on a 22-yarder en route to a 31-0 lead at the half.

Placekicker **Jefferson Souza** added three field goals of 31, 25 and 28 yards. Livingstone (4-1, 2-0, 0-0 S) managed just 24 rushing yards and eight first downs.

**• All-CIAA running back Stevie Green** ran for 187 yards (14 carries) including TD runs of 68, 25 and 30 yards as **FAYETTEVILLE STATE** celebrated homecoming with a 66-20 win over **Chowan**.

The Broncos (4-1, 2-0, 0-0 S) piled up 487 rushing yards and seven TDs with **Johannie Glasper** adding 112 rushing yards on four carries including a 79-yard scoring jaunt and **Darnell Walker** scoring on three short runs of 3, 7 and 11 yards.

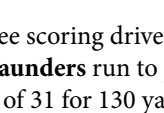
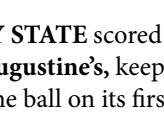
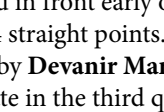
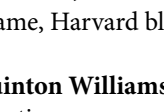
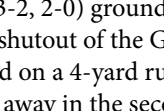
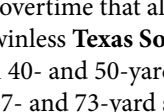
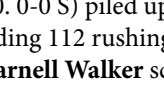
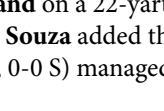
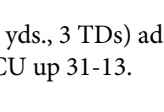
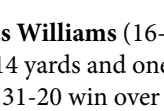
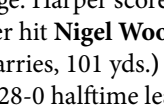
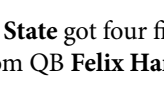
FSU QB **Richard Latimer** (11-16-0, 129 yds.) threw two TD passes.

**• QB Aqeel Glass** (28-38-0) threw for 377 yards and four TDs including a 12-yard game-winner in overtime that allowed **ALABAMA A&M** to a escape with a 35-28 win over **Texas Southern**. TSU (0-5, 0-2) trailed 28-13 before QB **Devin Williams** connected on 40- and 50-yard second half scoring passes to tie the score at 28.

Glass, who had 20-, 57- and 73-yard scoring passes thru three quarters, hit **Ibrahim Abdul-Fattai** with his second scoring catch to start the extra period. The A&M defense then kept TSU out of the end zone.

**• ALBANY STATE** (3-2, 2-0) ground out 234 rushing yards while holding **Tuskege** to just 47 yards on the ground in a 21-0 shutout of the Golden Tigers (1-4, 0-2).

RB **Tracy Scott** scored on a 4-yard run at the end of a 6-play, 69-yard drive in the first quarter and then went in from 6 yards away in the second quarter following an interception of TU QB **Ahmad Deramus** (11-22-3, 91 yds.), one of three for the Golden Rams on the day; **McKinley Habersham** led the ASU rushing effort with 127 yards on 21 carries.



## BIG LOSERS!

**• In a historic date at Harvard, HOWARD** (1-5, 1-1) laid an egg, falling to the Crimson 62-17 in the first meeting between the reputable HBCU and Ivy League institutions. The game was the first against an HBCU for Harvard.

On the field it was no match, as Harvard blocked Howard's first two punts on the way to building a 41-3 halftime lead. For the game, Harvard blocked three punts, recovered two fumbles, had seven sacks and 16 tackles for losses.

HU freshman QB **Quinton Williams** was a bright spot completing 13 of 23 passes for 224 yards and one TD without an interception.

## OFF THE SCHNEID!

**• Redshirt sophomore RB Kevin Dominique** ran for 129 yards and two TDs and QB **Gerald Hickbottom** added two scoring passes as **GRAMBLING STATE** (1-4, 1-2) got its first win of the season, 44-21 over **Jackson State** before a crowd of over 32,000 at Jackson's Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium.

JSU (1-4, 0-1) jumped in front early on a 2-yard **Jordan Johnson** run before Grambling reeled off 24 straight points. One of the scores came on a 70-yard blocked field goal return by **Devanir Martin**. Dominique capped the run with a 59-yard scoring jaunt late in the third quarter.

After JSU pulled within 24-14, GSU ripped off another 20 straight points including a 56-yard interception return by **Joseph McWilliams**. Dominique's 31-yard scoring run ended that run.

**• ELIZABETH CITY STATE** scored the game's first 20 points and held on to post its first win of the season 27-17 over **Saint Augustine's**, keeping the Falcons (0-5, 0-2) winless.

SAU fumbled away the ball on its first two plays from scrimmage. The Vikings (1-4, 1-1) converted the first on QB **Kedric Patterson's** 11-yard TD pass to **Brandon Joyner** with 8:34 to play.

Later, Patterson connected with **Dajuan Greene** on a 33-yard scoring strike to put ECSU up 14-0. The lead stretched to 20-0 after SAU's **Maurice Nelson** fumbled at the SAU 25. Five plays later, Patterson scored on a 1-yard run.

SAU put together three scoring drives to pull within 20-17 midway thru the fourth quarter. ECSU scored on a 5-yard **DeShaun Saunders** run to preserve the win.

Patterson finished 14 of 31 for 130 yards and two TDs but threw two picks. SAU sacked Patterson four times and had 12 tackles for losses.
